Dr. Panagiotakou is Specialized in Endocrinology, Diabetes & Metabolism (certified both from the Greek Ministry of Health and the European Board Examination). She is a member of the European Society of Endocrinology (ESE), European Society of Pediatric Endocrinology (ESPE), European Young Endocrine Scientists (EYES), European Menopause and Andropause Society (EMAS), and European Thyroid Association (ETA).

Dr. Panagiotakou was trained in Endocrinology in the 1<sup>st</sup> Department of Internal Medicine of Metaxa General Hospital and the Department of Endocrinology, Diabetes, and Metabolism of Sismanoglio-Amalia Fleming General Hospital.

She has a Master Degree in “Metabolic Bone Diseases” at the Medical School of National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and she is currently attending the Master of Science Program “Medical Research Methodology” at the Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.

Her main clinical and research activities are focused on metabolic bone diseases, and calcium and phosphorous disorders. During her training she has been actively involved in the management of rare diseases of calcium metabolism such as like familial hypocalciuric hypercalcemia, Digeorge syndrome, familial hyperparathyroidism, and pseudo-pseudohypoparathyroidism.

Since October 2019, she is a member of the multidisciplinary team of the Center of Expertise on Rare Endocrine Diseases (C.E.R.E.D) – Disorders of Calcium and Phosphate Metabolism.

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
